TIPS AND TRICKS FOR CBSE BOARD EXAMS

Here are a few tips and tricks which students should follow while preparing for the exams:

- 1. Start solving sample papers :** Students should start their preparation with sample papers as soon as possible to lessen exam anxiety and which also helps them to boost their confidence. As sample papers provide students with exam criteria, key methods, and a marking scheme.
- 2. Work on the weak areas :** Students left with one month left for their CBSE board examinations. Now it is high time that students should realize what their weak and strong subjects are and should start practicing them accordingly to avoid silly mistakes.
- 3. Complete your syllabus on time :** Try to complete the syllabus on time. - ✦ **Prioritize :** After planning, one should start prioritizing the subjects and topics as per the weightage and importance.
- ✦ **Prepare :** Completion of these two processes will ultimately land students in the preparation process when students need to follow up with the plan they have made.
- ✦ **Practice :** Last but not least and the most important point. The more you practice, the more you will get a better understanding of the subject and help them become a perfectionist.
