PAPER – A RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENT

SECTION - A

Meaning, nature and components of resources and environment. Resources and environment interface. Classification of Resources: Renewable and non-renewable, biotic (Forests, wildlife, livestock, fisheries and crops) and abiotic (Soils, water and minerals)

SECTION - B

Distribution and utilization of water, minerals and energy resources, their economic, environmental significance and conservation. Types and distribution of forests and fisheries – their economic, environmental significance and conservation. Major soil types and their distribution, problems of soil erosion and soil conservation.

SECTION - C

Human Resources: Quantitative and qualitative aspects of population, number, distribution, density, growth, literacy and urbanisation. Population Resources Relationship: population – resources regions of the world.

SECTION - D

Classification of Environment: Natural and Human, Man – environment interrelations with respect to population size, type of economy and technology, exploitation of natural resources and environmental hazards. Emerging Environmental Issues: Pollution, population explosion, food security, deforsetation, conservation of bio-diversity.
